RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF VANSCOY NO.345

BYLAW NO. 1-1996

A BYLAW TO PROHIBIT OBSTRUCTIONS ADJACENT TO CERTAIN ROAD ALLOWANCES

The Council of the Rural Municipality of Vanscoy No. 345, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

- 1. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - (a) "municipality" means the Rural Municipality of Vanscoy No.345 of Saskatchewan;
 - (b) "road" means any road allowance within the municipality other than:
 - (i) a private road; or
 - (ii) a provincial highway; or
 - (iii) a road or highway within the following hamlets, to wit: Dunfermline, Grandora, Pippin & SE 6-34-6 W3.
- 2. No person shall hereafter plant trees or shrubs or place stone, earth or gravel piles, portable structures, machinery or other objects on private property within:
 - ninety metres from the intersection of the centre lines of any municipal roads,
 - forty-five metres from the centre line of any municipal road.
- 3. The council may, by order, direct the owner of any private property upon which a tree or shrub has been planted, or a stone, earth or gravel pile, portable structure, machinery or other object has been placed in contravention of the provisions of section 2 hereof, to remove the same within a time stated in such order and the provisions of section 173 of The Rural Municipality Act, 1989, shall apply, mutates mutandis, if the owner fails to comply with the order.
- 4. Any person who contravenes the provisions of Section 2 hereof is guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to the penalties imposed in the general penalty bylaw of the municipality.
- 5. That Bylaw No. 10-1951 is hereby repealed.
