

RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF VANSCOY NO. 345

BYLAW No. 17-2021

The Anti-Dumping Bylaw

A Bylaw to Regulate and Control the Dumping of Waste on Property
Under the Ownership or Control of the Rural Municipality of Vanscoy No. 345
Pursuant to Section 8(2)(e) of *The Municipalities Act*.

The council of the Rural Municipality of Vanscoy No. 345, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw shall be referred to as the Anti-Dumping Bylaw
2. For the purpose of this bylaw the expression:
 - a. "**Act**" means *The Environmental Management and Protection Act, 2010* and any future revisions to such.
 - b. "**Dumping**" means abandoning waste or causing waste to be abandoned in any location other than in a receptacle provided for the collection of waste, as approved under the authority of the *Act*.
 - c. "**Municipality**" means the Rural Municipality of Vanscoy No. 345.
 - d. "**Waste**" has the meaning as defined in the *Act*, and any future revisions to such, including, without limitation, any discarded or abandoned organic or inorganic material, including material or by-products discarded in a manufacturing or producing process; dirt; rocks; rubble; garbage; tree cuttings; grass; leaves; empty or partly empty tins, boxes, cartons, bottles and containers; discarded paper and fabrics, discarded household utensils; household furniture; household appliances of any nature; trees; concrete; or any other refuse, rubble, or matter.
3. Pursuant to Section 50(1) of the *Act*, dumping waste within the Municipality is prohibited and any person found guilty of this offence shall be liable on summary conviction to the penalties provided pursuant to the penalties within the summary offense procedures regulations, in Section 84 of the *Act* or to the penalties contained in Schedule 1 to this Bylaw.
4. In addition to any penalty assessed, a person convicted of an offence pursuant to this bylaw shall also be responsible for the cost incurred by the Municipality for waste disposal and clean-up at an hourly rate and:
 - a. The charge shall not be less than a three and one half (3.5) hour minimum.
 - b. The hourly rate shall be calculated as the sum of the following:
 - i. Labour cost for two employees at the current union-negotiated rate for Group 1 Year 3 Operators.
 - ii. Equipment cost for a 10yd Tandem Truck at the current Custom Work Rate.

COMING INTO FORCE

This Bylaw shall come into force the 14th day of October, 2021,
