RURAL MUNICIPALITY OF VANSCOY NO. 345

BYLAW NO. 05-2021

DOGS RUNNING AT LARGE BYLAW

The council of the Rural Municipality of Vanscoy No. 345, in the Province of Saskatchewan, enacts as follows:

Short Title

This Bylaw may be cited as The Dog Bylaw

General Prohibition

2.

- (1) No dog shall run at large in the Municipality, and for the purpose of this bylaw, a dog shall be deemed to be running at large when it is beyond the boundaries of the land occupied by the owner, possessor, or harbourer of the dog; or beyond the boundaries of any lands where it may with the permission of the owner or occupant of the said land, and when it is not under control by being:
 - (a) In direct and continuous charge of a person capable of controlling/handling it; or
 - (b) Securely confined within an enclosure; or
 - (c) Securely fastened so it cannot roam at will
- (2) A person who owns, possesses, or harbours a dog found running at large shall be deemed guilty of an infraction of this Bylaw.
- (3) A person who contravenes any of the provisions of this Bylaw, shall be guilty of an offence and upon conviction, shall be liable to a penalty of:

(a) First Offence:

\$150.00

(b) Second Offence:

\$250.00

(c) Third or Subsequent Offences:

\$500.00

- (4) A violator of this Bylaw, upon being served a Summary Offence Ticket, may during municipal office hours voluntarily pay the penalty at the Municipal Office, and upon payment as so provided, that person shall not be liable for prosecution of the offence.
- (5) That Bylaw No. 4-1998 be hereby repealed.
